

Tool 2.b Primary students' consultation tool

Staff Notes

The purpose of this tool is to consult with primary students about their learning needs to inform the development of the curriculum.

Resources required

Question box

Procedure

1. Prepare a question box for the classroom that students can post slips of paper into.
2. Write a list of relationships and sexuality education topics on the board relevant to the year level. For a suggested list please see the topic areas listed in Segment 5.
3. Explain to students that the information collected in the question box will help teachers plan and deliver the relationships and sexuality education program. Invite students to write down questions or comments about these topics on a slip of paper and place them in the question box. Inform students that they can add extra topics they would like to learn about. This can be done anonymously.
4. Leave the questions box somewhere in the classroom and allow the student a few days to add any additional thoughts, questions or comments.
5. Use the data collected from the students to help develop your relationships and sexuality education program.
